Projects - 40%

- Carefully planned and designed works of art.
- Graded using a rubric based on specific criteria.
- 1 6 point system: Points will convert into a % grade based on the CHS grading scale. Please see class website for a sample rubric and grade scale.

Sketchbooks – 25%

• Bell Ringers, Classwork, Critiques, Etc. Weekly Progress–20%

- Art is a hands-on process. Therefore, this grade is based on work ethic.

Exams – 15%
